These scholarships are available only to current Year 12 students or students who completed Year 12 studies previously.

If you apply for one of our scholarships, are selected into one of the above courses, and receive an ENTER of at least 75, you are guaranteed a scholarship of at least \$1,200 for each of your three years of study.

Selection is based on your performance in VCE or equivalent.
