

REGULATION 8.1 – THE UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

Interpretation

1. In this Regulation, unless a contrary intention appears:
“Head of Branch” means the head of the Information Services Branch or equivalent;
“Vice-Chancellor” means the Vice-Chancellor or nominee.

The Library

2. (1) The University Library shall consist of all collections of books, magazines, films, digital media, equipment and other materials used or capable of being used for the purposes of teaching and research in the University declared by resolutions of Vice-Chancellor made from time to time to form part of the Library.
(2) The Vice-Chancellor may sub-divide part of the Library into campus libraries.
(3) The Council may declare the name of the Library and any campus libraries.

Library committee

3. The Head of Branch may constitute a library committee consisting of such ex-officio, nominated, appointed and elected members as are prescribed, which shall:
 - (a) recommend to the Vice-Chancellor policies with respect to the organisation and development of the Library facilities of the University in support of teaching and research;
 - (b) determine plans and budgets for the organisation of the Library and its resources and services;
 - (c) regularly review progress towards achievement of approval plans and budgets;
 - (d) recommend to the Vice-Chancellor rules governing conduct in and the use of the Library;
 - (e) advise the Vice-Chancellor of library services and provisions sought by users of the Library;
 - (f) suggest to the Vice-Chancellor, policies and procedures to meet the needs of users of the Library;
 - (g) consider and advise on matters referred to it by the Vice-Chancellor; and
 - (h) have any other responsibilities, powers and duties as are conferred upon it by resolution of the Council or the Vice-Chancellor.

Library rules

4. (1) On the recommendation of the Head of Branch or Library committee, the Vice-Chancellor may prescribe rules governing conduct in and use of the Library.
(2) Rules prescribed under sub-section (1) may prescribe fines and other penalties which may be imposed by the Head of Branch for breaches of the rules.
(3) The rules in force at the date of coming into operation of this Regulation shall remain in force until such time as the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of the Head of Branch or Library Committee repeals or amends the rules.

Use of the Library

5.
 - (1) The Library is available for use by all members of the University subject to their compliance with the Library rules.
 - (2) The Vice-Chancellor may permit any person who is not a member of the University to use the Library and, if he or she thinks fit, may require any such person to undertake in writing to observe the Library rules.
